**Notes:**

This table takes levels of equivalised income for the population as a whole and translates them into cash equivalents for different family types. For example, for results Before Housing Costs, it shows that 60 per cent of median (equivalised) income was £194 per week. This translates to a cash income of £118 for a single person with no children. This does not imply that, to obtain this figure we work out the median income for single people and take 60 per cent of that figure. Rather, that a single person needs a cash income of £118 or less to be below 60 per cent of median (equivalised) income for the population as a whole.
