NOTE IN ANNEX 1 SECTION 6.7

The note referred to in the tables above was as follows:

Asylum seekers and other types of persons from abroad can claim IS under certain circumstances. Their personal allowance is reduced by 10%. Changes to the benefit rules were introduced in February 1996. Only those asylum seekers who make an application for asylum when they first arrive in the UK, or whose countries have been declared an upheaval country can claim IS or income-based Jobseeker's Allowance. Entitlement ceases in the event of an initial negative decision from the Home Office on the asylum seeker's application, and benefit is no longer payable during the asylum appeal process. Asylum seekers in receipt of benefit when the changes were introduced are covered by transitional protection up until the next negative Home Office decision on their application.
