

Managing people and performance

Level 1: AA – AO

Delivering results

Knows what is required in their day to day work and takes responsibility for working to a consistently high standard by:

- Agreeing role requirements with those they report to and work with;
- Planning and managing day-to-day workload to meet agreed targets and deadlines;
- Consistently applying policies and procedures that are relevant to the role;
- Recognising and reporting risks to the successful completion of work.
- Making best use of the available technology and ensuring security of personal and other official information.

Deploying People and Resources Effectively

Makes best use of own time and other resources by:

- Monitoring how their time is used and proposing more efficient ways of working;
- Reducing wastage and encouraging others to do the same;
- Considering the environmental impact of their actions.

Managing Finance

Helps to achieve value for money by:

- Applying relevant financial and procurement procedures;
- Considering value for money of all their actions;
- Raising relevant queries on financial reporting.

Level 2: EO – SEO

Delivering results

Manages own and others' performance to ensure outputs are delivered on schedule and to the required quality by:

- Setting clear objectives that are in line with business needs;
- Putting in place clear delivery plans and monitoring progress and outputs;
- Identifying, assessing and managing risks in order to minimise their impact on performance;
- Ensuring compliance, and addressing non-compliance, with DWP policies and practices.

Deploying People and Resources Effectively

Is flexible and creative in deploying resources to best effect by:

- Making best use of people's skills and availability to deliver business objectives;
- Considering diversity-related needs when planning and allocating work;
- Taking action to increase efficiency;
- Demonstrating flexibility and creativity in delivering with less resources;

- Considering sustainability issues and encouraging others to assess the environmental impact of their work.
- Ensuring access to available technology and making sure that information security systems are in place.

Managing Finance

Works within budget limits to deliver best value for money by:

- Considering budget limits when allocating resources;
 - Analysing the value for money of alternative options before committing to spending;
 - Advising on cost implications of plans and activities;
 - Monitoring income and expenditure and demonstrating where savings can be made.
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Level 3: Grade 6-7

Delivering results

Directs efforts to maximise the contribution of their own area of work by:

- Understanding the implications of strategic decisions for their own area of responsibility;
- Clarifying business priorities and checking that activities are aligned to these;
- Agreeing roles and responsibilities of staff and stakeholders, and securing individual and team ownership of objectives;
- Anticipating potential risks and acting swiftly to mitigate high impact/high probability risks;
- Promoting compliance with DWP policies, procedures, regulations and information security measures.

Deploying People and Resources Effectively

Determines priorities and allocates resources to best meet business goals by:

- Ensuring resources are in place;
- Clarifying business priorities and focusing resources accordingly;
- Developing plans that use resources efficiently and in ways that maximise the benefits of having a diverse workforce;
- Considering implications for sustainable development when assessing proposals.

Managing Finance

Devises plans and prepares budgets that deliver value for money and support the financial objectives of the organisation by:

- Ensuring accurate financial reporting and considering financial data when making decisions;
- Ensuring funding requirements are approved before committing to spend;
- Developing plans and budgets which identify value for money and opportunities for cost reduction;
- Engaging with finance experts when appropriate;
- Leading by example when incurring expenditure.
